Tops Day Nursery is discounted for Trust staff. Shift pattern bookings are available and it is based on the hospital campus.



KEY WORKER HOUSING

There are a set amount of properties available from each housing association that are reserved exclusively for the use of key workers. The scheme is open to all clinical NHS employees (excluding doctors and dentists) but please take note that eligible job roles may vary between local authorities, in order to establish definitive judgments it is advisable to contact local HomeBuy agencies.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT
