PORTSMOUTH HOSPITALS NHS TRUST GENERAL CHARITABLE FUND REPORT TO TRUST BOARD – April 2012

Issue for consideration:

To update the Trust Board, in their capacity as Trustee, on recent charity activity.

Action required by Trust Board

1. Total Funds

Portsmouth Hospitals NHS Trust General Charitable Fund has a fund balance of £3,646,247 as at 30th April 2012.

2. Charitable Income

During the month of April 2012, the Portsmouth Hospitals NHS Trust General Charitable Funds received donations and fundraising income of £25,505. including:

- £4,000 from a regular donor for the benefit of children with prosthetics.
- The Rocky Appeal raised funds amounting £10,101.
- A grateful patient donated £3,500 to the Colorectal Research fund for the care and support she received from Dr Senapati.

3. Charitable Expenditure

During the month of April 2012, the Portsmouth Hospitals NHS Trust General Charitable Fund spent £98,071 including the following items of note:

- The Cardiology fund purchased an Intra Aortic Balloon Pump at a cost of £45,000.
- The Renal Research Fund continued to support research, spending £18,978 during April.
- ENT provided £6,000 funding for the purchase of a Nasendoscope.

4. Rocky Appeal

Net funds raised at the 30th April 2012, including investment income, for the current appeal amount to £1,814,743. The third laparoscopic theatre is estimated to cost £300,000 leaving £197,743 available to cover running costs for the appeal and to go towards the next project.
