PORTSMOUTH HOSPITALS NHS TRUST GENERAL CHARITABLE FUND REPORT TO TRUST BOARD – May 2012

Issue for consideration:

To update the Trust Board, in their capacity as Trustee, on recent charity activity.

Action required by Trust Board

1. Total Funds

Portsmouth Hospitals NHS Trust General Charitable Fund has a fund balance of £3,593,059 as at 31st May 2012.

2. Charitable Income

During the month of May 2012, the Portsmouth Hospitals NHS Trust General Charitable Funds received donations and fundraising income of £15,970. including:

- Fundraising income of £8,758 for The Rocky Appeal.
- Over £1,000 was received in donations within the Cancer Information Centre.
- A donor raised £1,046 for the benefit of the Renal Charitable Fund.

3. Charitable Expenditure

During the month of May 2012, the Portsmouth Hospitals NHS Trust General Charitable Fund spent £68,281 including the following items of note:

- A Lucas chest compression system costing £10,090 was purchased from the Cardiology Charitable Fund.
- The Eye department purchased medical equipment costing £10,160.
- £4,966 was spent on conference fees, accommodation and flights to attend the British Renal Society Conference.

4. Rocky Appeal

Net funds raised at the 31st May 2012, including investment income, for the current appeal amount to £1,816,490. The third laparoscopic theatre is estimated to cost £300,000 leaving £199,491 available to cover running costs for the appeal and to go towards the robotic theatre suite.
