## Freedom of Information request

Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, which was received by our Freedom of Information team on 26/05/2020.

1) How many complaints through the patient advice and liaison system (PALS) your Trust received from patients alleging they had been discriminated against or badly treated by a member of staff because of their being overweight or obese

Please do this by searching for complaints containing any of the words "weight", "fat", "obese", "overweight" and "bariatric" and filtering these to find those that refer to fat-shaming comments made by a member of staff.

In 2019 the Trust had received one complaint through the patient advice and liaison system (PALS). This was not a formal complaint.

- 2) Can you select the first five such complaints from 2019 and provide me with the following details:
- a. What type of staff member was the complaint levelled against?

  A Consultant.
- b. Please quote the words allegedly used by the hospital staff or summarise the offending action?

"Fat".

c. Please tell me what, if any, action was taken by your trust in response to these five sample complaints from the beginning of 2019?

The mother of the patient had been contacted via telephone, apologies and support had been given by to the patient by the Trust.
