The Trust already has some LED lighting in place across its estate, as any upgrade or new developments in the last two to three years will have incorporated LED lighting. The Trust is about to start a planned programme to replace all remaining lighting with LED over the next three years which will be covered under the PFI contract.

We are unable to provide specific figures relating to 20/21 expenditure on energy efficient schemes as these costs will have formed part of these upgrades / developments.

The costs of purchasing light bulbs are incurred by our PFI service provider, therefore we don't hold this information.

The Trust's carbon foot printing is being developed nationally by the greener NHS using data provided by Trust's from the Estates Returns Information Collection (ERIC) <https://digital.nhs.uk/data-and-information/publications/statistical/estates-returns-information-collection>, this is a work in process to enable consistent reporting nationally <https://www.england.nhs.uk/greenernhs/>

The Trust has not carried out any local carbon foot printing.
