

## **Southern Endometriosis Centre**

### **What we do:**

The endometriosis clinic at Queen Alexandra Hospital will see patients from all over the southern region, many who have been referred from their GP because they require a specialist opinion. We work with a variety of patients, including those awaiting diagnosis or others who may have a long history of the condition.

On your first visit, it is likely that you will be seen by a specialist Consultant who will take a detailed history from you. Sometimes you may see a Gynaecology Registrar if the Consultant is not available. They will ask about any medications you may be taking, any previous operations you may have had and other questions in relation to your gynaecology history. If any further investigations are required the Consultant can organise these for you.

We offer an Endometriosis Specialist Clinic on Wednesday mornings. Clear treatment pathways are agreed with women affected with endometriosis; sometimes this may mean surgery but can also involve pain medication or hormonal treatments.
