### Thematic Priority 1

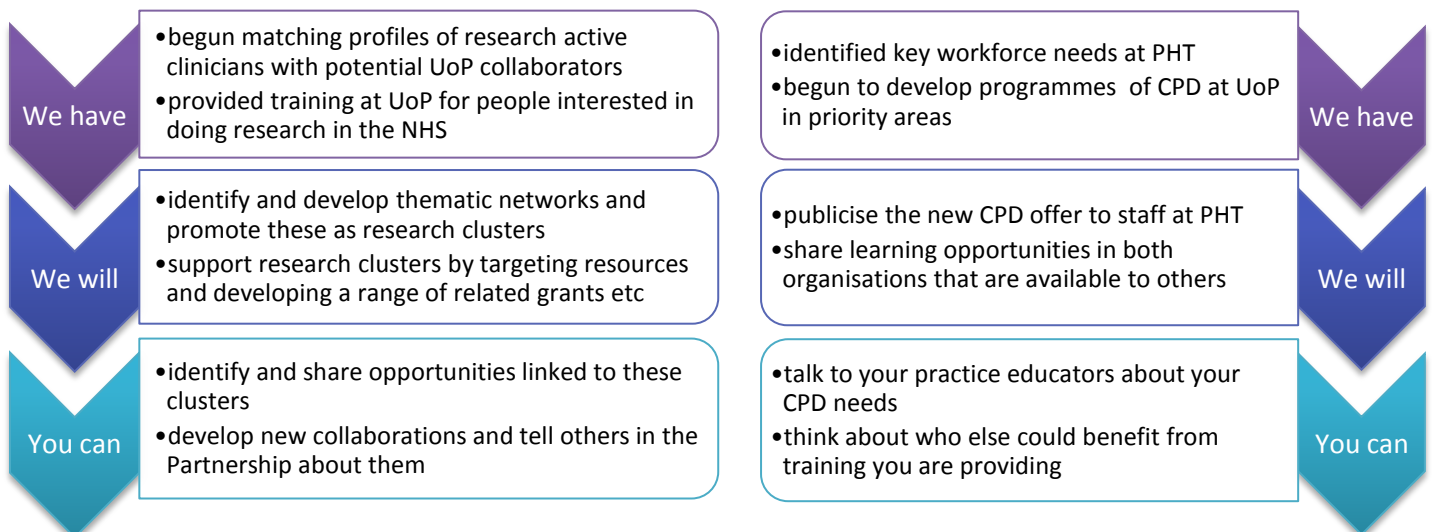
**Identify and develop research and innovation networks around key thematic areas, leading to more shared grants, stronger research and improved individual and collective health and wellbeing**

Progress in these thematic priorities will be underpinned by improvements in two key areas:
