This month's clinical questions are...

For children with chronic asthma receiving inhaled corticosteroids (ICSs), how does adjunct formoterol compare with salmeterol in terms of serious adverse events?

For healthy children under the age of three years, what are the effects of zinc supplements for preventing otitis media?

For infants and children younger than 5 years of age, what are the effects of vitamin D supplementation on linear growth and other health outcomes?

What are the effects of antidepressants for children and adolescents with functional abdominal pain disorders?

What are the effects of nebulized deoxyribonuclease (rhDNase) for children under 24 months of age with viral bronchiolitis?

What are the benefits and harms of ibuprofen for preventing patent ductus arteriosus (PDA) in preterm and/or low birth weight infants?

What is the impact of nutritional standards on the consumption/sales of sugar-sweetened beverages in schools?

Primary Research

Title: The effect of saline versus air for cuff inflation on the incidence of high intra-cuff pressure in paediatric MicroCuff ® tracheal tubes: a randomised controlled trial

Abstract/Conclusion: The use of saline to inflate the cuff of paediatric cuffed tubes reduces the incidence of high intra-cuff pressures during anaesthesia. This may provide a pragmatic extra safety barrier to help reduce the incidence of excessive tracheal cuff pressure when nitrous oxide is used during paediatric anaesthesia.

Title: Health behaviour outcomes of a family based intervention for paediatric obesity in primary care: A randomized type II hybrid effectiveness-implementation trial.

Abstract/Conclusion: The FCU4Health, delivered in coordination with paediatric primary care, significantly impacted child and family health behaviours that are associated with the development and maintenance of paediatric obesity. BMI did not significantly differ.

Title: Healthcare professionals' views of the use of oral morphine and transmucosal diamorphine in the management of paediatric breakthrough pain and the feasibility of a randomised controlled trial: A focus group study (DIPPER)

Abstract/Conclusion: There were perceived advantages to transmucosal diamorphine, but there is a need for access to a safe preparation. A clinical trial would be feasible provided barriers were overcome.

Title: A Mixed-Methods Analysis of Medication Safety Incidents Reported in Neonatal and Children's Intensive Care

Abstract/Conclusion: Neonates were commonly involved in medication-related incidents reported in children's intensive care settings. Improvements in staffing and workload, design of systems and processes, and the use of anti-infective medications may reduce this risk.

Title: Racial and Ethnic Diversity in Studies Funded Under the Best Pharmaceuticals for Children

Abstract/Conclusion: This study revealed no evidence of racial and ethnic bias in enrollment for pediatric studies conducted with funding from BPCA, fulfilling the legislation's expectation to ensure adequate representation of all children.

Title: To prescribe or not to prescribe for paediatric sore throat: a retrospective cohort study comparing clinician-led antibiotic prescriptions to FeverPAIN and Centor scoring in a tertiary paediatric emergency department and a national review of practice.

Abstract/Conclusion: Current guidance is variably interpreted and inconsistently implemented in paediatric populations. FeverPAIN and Centor scoring systems may not rationalise antibiotics as much as previously reported compared with judicious clinician practice. Producing clear paediatric-specific national guidelines, especially for under-5s who are omitted from NICE sore throat guidance, may help further rationalise and standardise antibiotic use in paediatric tonsillopharyngitis.
