Rapid Investigation Service ICE Panel

The use of this RIS panel is not mandatory. It is to assist GPs request necessary tests, enable timely referrals and support the patient to be sent direct to investigation or avoid unnecessary investigations. Additional tests may be required; this panel should be used in conjunction with the RIS referral form.

Rapid investigation service	Full blood count ESR CXR Renal profile C-Reactive protein LFT Bone profile Fasting glucose HBA1C PSA CA125 FIT Faecal elastase	Mandatory filter test results from within the past 2 months Faecal Immunochemical Test (FIT) within 3 months CXR is an optional filter test Faecal elastase is only required if fasting glucose or HbA1c is newly raised Please note results are required prior to referral to ensure the most suitable pathway can be used Please refer to the Rapid Investigation Service referral form and check for any other referral requirements.
